




How to Start

The online catalog of the Zurich James Joyce Foundation is available at https://www.zotero.org/zurich_james_joyce_foundation/library.

If you click on the link, you will see the library catalog in your browser window. It will look something like this, depending on the settings of your computer:



or



dark mode

light mode

You can change from light to dark mode (and vice versa) by clicking on the following symbol, in the top-right corner of your screen, just above the catalog: ••• ~

In what follows, we will use light mode to explain how you can use the catalog.


Basic Settings

When you use the catalog for the first time on a given computer, you will very likely have to make certain adjustments before you can use the search function effectively.

Specifically, you will have to click on the following icon to add certain columns:


You can find this icon in the top-right corner of your screen, and after clicking on it, you should select the following from the menu:






- Select "Publication Title"
- De-select "Attachment"
- Click on "More" and then select "Call Number"

Note that the catalog will look slightly different, depending on the width of your browser window (i.e. some elements will appear in different places on your screen):








Basic Search

There are different ways in which you can search the catalog. The easiest type of search is by title, creator, and/or year.



narrow search to:


- Audio
- Texts
- Video & DVD

Keyword Search

In addition to the basic search, you can use the keyword search:




There are two ways to do so:

- You can type a search term into the "Filter Tags" field.
- You can select keywords from the keyword index.



Note:

- You can select multiple keywords.
- If you can't find any items, you may have forgotten to deselect keywords from an earlier search,



Click on the three dots to see how many keywords you have selected (or to "Deselect All" keywords)
